	Refer to the apartment inspection checklist your landlord gave you when moving in.		Clean out the refrigerator as thoroughly as possible. Remove the drawers if necessary to reach everywhere.
	Review this checklist and customize it, creating a list of everything you need to do before leaving.		Scrub the stove, including the oven, all drip pans and burners.
			Sweep behind appliances.

	Restore walls to their previous condition. Remove nails and hooks, and fill in holes.		Polish the sink and faucet.
